**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**BETWEEN**

**ISFAHAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (IRAN)**

**AND**

**ULSAN NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SOUTH KOREA)**

Isfahan University of Technology of Iran (IUT) and Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology (UNIST) of South Korea are wishing to enhance relations between the two institutions and to develop academic exchanges in the areas of education, research and other cultural and academic activities, hereby agree to cooperate and to work together towards the internationalization of higher education, in general, the enhancement of mutual understanding and friendship between the two institutions, in particular.

The areas of cooperation will include superfunctional nanomaterials and nanodevices; which are considered to be desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of the cooperative relationships between the two institutions. The cooperation program shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds, and approval of each institution. Such programs include:

- Exchange of faculty members as visiting professor or adjunct professor
- Exchange of students for research projects,
- Joint education and training programs (Master and PhD),
- Joint research projects,
- Joint conferences,
- Cooperation in publishing International journals,
- Presenting Short-term courses,
- Exchange of scientific materials and information,
- Joint cultural programs.

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible officers of the two parties prior to the initiation of any specific program of activity.

This agreement shall be effective upon approval by the two parties and shall remain in effect for a period of five years from the date of signing, thereafter to be automatically renewed on a yearly basis. This agreement may be revised after consultation and with the mutual consent of the two institutions. However, after the initial period either one institution may terminate the agreement at the end of a given year by giving a notice in writing of such intent six months beforehand.
